AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE CITY AIRPORT PROPERTY WITH E. ALLEN PROPST AND ZENA M. PROPST FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM THE FIRST DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1956, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> The council of the City of Albany do by the passage of this ordinance, deem it improper to attain bids for the lease of the airport property for a period of one year beginning September 1, 1956.

<u>Section 2:</u> The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into a lease agreement for the Albany City Airport property with E. Allen Propst and Zena M. Propst for a period of one year beginning September 1, 1956; said lease to be in substantially the same form as that marked "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

<u>Section 3:</u> The Council, by this ordinance, does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

<u>Section 4:</u> Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany require that this ordinance become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor for reasons that the present lease terminated August 29, 1956, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
