AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE PUBLIC NECESSITY FOR A STREET; DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO INSTITUTE CONDIMINATION PROCEEDINGS AND APPOINTING THREE VIEWERS FOR THE SAID PROPERTY.

Section 1: Public necessity requires a street over the following described property:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Block 4, Hollywood Acres Addition in Albany, Linn County, Oregon, as platted and recorded in the Records of Linn County, and running

thence South 89 degrees C4: West 758.8 feet parallel with Nineteenth Avenue as laid out in said addition, to a point on the Easterly Line of Thurston Street.

thence South 1 degree 301 East 50 feet along the said Easterly line of Thurston Street;
