AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF CONCRETE DRAINAGE PIPE WITH WILLAMETTE CONCRETE PIPE AND TILE COMPANY OF ALBANY, OREGON, IN A SUM NOT TO EXCEED SIX HUNDRED NINETY THREE DOLLARS (\$693.00). AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, do, by the passage of this ordinance, deem it impractible to obtain bids for concrete drainage pipe for the replacement of the dump ground road bridge.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of concrete drainage pipe at a cost not to exceed Six Hundred Ninety Three Dollars (\$693.00) for the replacement of the bridge on the dump ground road with the Willamette Concrete Pipe & Tile Company of Albany, Oregon.

Section 3: The Council, by this ordinance, does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

Section 4: Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
