ORDINANCE NO. 2708

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY FOR A SEWER EASEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Southern Pacific Company for the purpose of obtaining an easement for sewer purposes on the said Southern Pacific Companies property. The agreement shall be an addenda to an agreement entered into with the Southern Pacific Company and the City of Albany on the 26th day of September, 1923, and shall provide for payment to the Southern Pacific Company in the sum of \$45.00.

Section 2: Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
