ORDINANCE NO. 2710

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2680, PROVIDING FOR THE DATE AND MANNER FOR HOLDING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THAT FORTION OF GOLTRA PARK ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY ON THE 14TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1956, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE SAID TERRITORY FOR THEIR ADOPTION OR REJECTION THE REOPOSAL TO ANNEX THE SAID FORTION OF GOLTRA PARK ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO OR DAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: In a manner provided by law and in this ordinance for the Biological and the said day, and continuing until 8:00 o'clock P.M. on the said day.

Section 2: The following is hereby designated as the voting place of the said election, the same being a voting place within the said territory:

Charles Draper

Queen Avenue & Thurston Street

Section 3: The judges and clerks of the said special election shall supervise the election within the below described territory shall be as follows:

Judges:

1. Laurene Laubner 2. Retta Mae Draper

Clerks:

1. June C. Northey 2. Lucille McConnell 3. Lorraine Hiddleson

Section 4: The City Recorder shall cause notice of the said special election to be given by publication thereof in a newspaper of general circulation within the city, once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks. The first date of publication to be on the 16th day of November, 1956, and the said notice shall state the time, voting place and description of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Section 5: The City Recorder, in addition to the notices required in Section 4, shall cause to be posted in four (4) conspicuous places within the territory proposed to be annexed on or before the 16th day of November, 1956, notices of special election to be in the following form:

"SPECIAL ELECTION NOTICE

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 14th day of "ecember, 1956, at the Charles Draper residence, Thurston Street at Queen Avenue, Albany, Gregon, in the Sunrise precinct, in Goltra Park Addition to the City of Albany, a special election will be held concerning the proposed annexation of the following described territory to the City of Albany:

Beginning at the intersecting point of the north line of Queen Avenue and the east line of Marion Street extended:

thence south to the southwest corner of Block 1, Goltra Park Addition;

thence east along the south line of Blocks 1 & 2, Goltra Park Addition to the southwest corner of Block 3, Goltra Park Addition;

thence south along the west line of Blocks 6 & 11 Goltra Park Addition to the south line of "D" Street; thence west along the south line of "D" Street 5 feet;

thence southerly along the east line of Jackson Street (formerly Park Avenue) 683.0 feet; thence casterly parallel to the south line of Block 3,

Goltra Fark Addition 457 feet; more or less to a point on the present city limits of Albany, Linn County, Oregon; thence northerly and westerly following the present city limits of Albany, Oregon, to the place of

beginning.

Which election will be held at 8:00 o'clock in the morning and will continue until 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon of the said day.

Registered voters of the said territory are invited to vote upon the proposed annexation.

Section 6: The said special election and the proposed annexation of the territory described above shall be submitted to the legal voters in the said territory for their adoption or rejection as hereinafter set forth in Section 7.

Section 7: Proposal to annex the said portion of Goltra Park Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon:

"AN ACT to annex the following described territory, (being a portion of Goltra Park Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon) to the City of Albany:

Beginning at the intersecting point of the north line of Queen Avenue and the east line of Marion Street extended; thence south to the southwest corner of Block 1, Goltra Park Addition; thence east along the south line of Blocks 1 & 2, Goltra Park Addition to the southwest corner of Block 3, Goltra Park Addition; thence south along the west line of Blocks 6 & 11, Goltra Park Addition to the south line of "D" Street; thence West along the South line of "D" Street, 5 feet; thence southerly along the east line of Jackson Street (formerly Park

Avenue) 683.0 feet; thence easterly parallel to the south line of Block 3, Goltra Park Addition 457 feet; more or less to a point on the present city limits of Albany, Linn County, Oregon; thence northerly and westerly following the present city limits of

Albany, Oregon, to the place of beginning.

Section 8: Ordinance No. 2680 is hereby repealed.

Section 9: Inasmuch as the special election and the date of holding the same must, for the convenience, peace and health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, and the said territory to be annexed be held on the date aforesaid, an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
