an ordinance annexing a portion of first addition to rodgers addition; a portion of rodgersdale adoition; and the d, e. nebergall heat conpany property contiguous to the city of albany, oregon.

WHEREAS, on the 9 th day of January, 1957, at a regular Council Meeting, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, did duly pass Ordinance No. 2726, Ordinance No. 2727, and Ordinance No. 2728, wherein it was provided that a Public Hearing would be held on the 13 th day of February, 1957, conceraing advisability of annexation of a portion of Rodgers Addition, a portion of Rodgersdale Addition, and the D. E. Nebergall Neat Company Property contiguous to the City of Albany, Oregon.

Wherens, the hearing was duly held on the 13 th day of Fobruary, 1957, and at that time, the Council determined that the notices of the hearing had been duly given as provided in the aaid Ordinances and pursuant to the terns of 222.120 O.R.S., and

WHEREAS, the Council, after said hearing, determined that the said portion of Rodgers Addition, a portion of Rodgersdale Addition, and the D. E. Nebergall Neat Company Property, be annexed to the City of Albany, Oregon, and the consent of the property owners have been filed giving their consent for the said annexation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLONS:
Section 1: That the following described property be and it is hereby annexed to the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit:

## Rodgers Addition: The South fifty feet of Lot 34 in First Addition to Rodgers Acres, Linn County, Oregon.

Rodgersdale Addition: Beginning at a point on the boundary of the present city limits, which point being South 130 feet along the East line of the Truett Davis D.L.C. 754 from the Southeast corner of the Hirass Smead D.L.C. No. 53; thence along the West boundary of the Rodgersdale Addition to the Southwest corner of said addition; thence along the Southerly boundary of the Rodgersdale Addition to the Southeast corner of said addition; thence along the East boundary of the Rodgersdale Addition to the Northeast corner of Lot 6, 3lock. 30 of said addition; thence Northerly to the Southeast corner of Lot 17, of the First Addition to Rodgers Acres; thence Vesterly along the South line of Lots 17 and 34 of the First Addition to Rodgers Acres to the Southwest corner of Lot 34 of said addition, which point being also a point on the present city liait boundary.
D. E.
