AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE COST OF CERTAIN IMFROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY HAS DETERMINED IN RESOLUTION NO. 372, ADOPTED BY THE SAID COUNCIL ON THE 3IST DAY OF MAY, 1956, AND RESOLUTION NO. 374, ADOPTED BY THE SAID COUNCIL ON THE 11TH DAY OF JULY, 1956, FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE FOLLOW-ING DESCRIBED AREA BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN STREET IMPROVEMENTS AND DE-CLARING AN EMERGENCY:

BURKHART STREET IMPROVEMENT

EAST FIRST AVENUE IMPROVEMENT

to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such cost of such improvement of said street or streets, that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of street improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessments in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 31st day of May, 1956, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution requiring the City Engineer, or appoint Consulting Engineers to make plans, specifications for the improvement of said described area by the construction of said streets, and for the estimates of work to be done on said portion of said streets, and the probable costs thereof, and requiring that such plans, specifications, and estimates be filed in the Recorders Office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed Resolution No. 372, and filed said plans, specifications, and estimates in the Recorders Office of said City on the 31st day of May, 1956.

WHEREAS, the Council on the 31st day of May, 1956, by Resolution No. 372, and on the 11th day of July, 1956, by Resolution No. 374, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient, and that said Council proposed to make the improvements in the above stated manner.

WHEREAS, no remonstrances were filed after notice was given as provided by law, and the Council of the City of Albany on the 11th day of July, 1956, duly passed Ordinance No. 2667, establishing a time and manner of making said improvements.

WHEREAS, the said improvements aforesaid, have been duly made in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon and with the Charter of the City of Albany, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the cost of making said improvement of said described area by the construction of streets in the manner heretofore deemed by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, and by Resolution No. 372, Resolution No. 374, and Ordinance No. 2667 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said streets and particularly benefitted thereby is hereby declared to be the sum of \$9,817.06, of which the City shall pay as its share for the construction of streets in the sum of \$936.47, leaving a balance of \$6,860.59 to be assessed to property owners benefitted.

Section 2: The proportionate share of said costs of the improvement of said described area by the construction of streets assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said streets, improve and particularly benefitted thereby is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each such lots or parts thereof as follows:
