## THE PEOPLE OF THE CLTY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

A parion, having the qualifications as provided in Section 13 of the City Cherter alay be nominated for office by either of following methods:
(a) A person may declare himself a candidate for elective office by flling with the Recorder, in substantially the following form, his declaration of candidacy, together with a flling fee of Five Dollars ( $\$ 5.00$ ).

(b) A petition may be filed with the Recorder nominating a person as candidate for office. The petition must contaln twenty-five (25) signatures of persons having the same qualifications as the office sought, as provided in Section 13 of the Charter. In addition, the candidate must sign an acceptance of nomination. When filed with the Recorder, the Recorder shall check the signatures for validity. A person signing a nominating petition shall sign only one petition for each office.

## Section 2: FILING OF NOMINATIONS:

Nominations shall be filed on and after August 5th and before 5:00 p.m. on August 20th of each year of the biennial election.

## Section 3: NOTICE OF NCMINATIONS:

Not less than ninety days prior to each general election, the City Recorder shall post on the Bulletin Board of the City Hall a list of officers to be elected at the next General Election. This notice shall remain posted until nominations are closed. In addition, the Recorder shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation, published within the City, a like notice on two occasions not more than ninety days nor less than seventy-five days prior to the General Election.

## The Notlce shall be substantially in the following form:

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Quallfications as prescribed in the Charter of the
Clty of Albany are as follows:

The candidate must be a qualified elector within the meaning of the Constitution of Oregon and have resided in the city during the twelve (12) months immediately preceding the election and in the Ward he seeks to represent, in case of Counclimen, for a period of ninety days immedlately prior to election.
