ORDINANCE NO. 2862

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE DATE AND MANNER OF HOLDING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN AREA NO.5, A PORTION OF NORTH ALBANY, ON THE 18TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1959, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE SAID TERRITORY FOR THEIR ADOPTION OR REJECTION A PROPOSAL TO ANNEX A PORTION OF NORTH ALBANY TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: DAY AND TIME FOR ELECTION

That in a manner provided by law and in this Ordinance and for the purpose set forth herein, a special election shall be held in Area No.5, a portion of North Albany, Benton County, Oregon, as below described on the 18th day of December, 1959, commencing at the hour of 8 o'clock a.m. on the said, day, Pacific Standard Time.

Section 2: VOTING PLACE

That the following is hereby designated as the voting place of the said election: Fairmount orange Hall.

Section 3: JUDGE AND CLERKS

That the Judge and Clerks of the said special election who shall supervise the election within the below described territory, shall be:

Mrs. Jean Anderson, Judge Mrs. Addie McFarland, Clerk Mrs. Mary Radford, Clerk

Section 4: NOTICE

The City Recorder shall cause notice of the said special election to be given by publication thereof in a newspaper of general circulation within the city once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks, first date of publication to be the 20th day of November, 1959, and said notice shall state the time, voting place, and a description of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Section 5: POSTED NOTICES

The Recorder, in addition to the notice required in Section 4 above, shall cause to be posted in four (4) conspicuous places within the territory proposed to be annexed at least ten (10) days before the date of the special election, notices of the special election in the following form:

"SPECIAL ELECTION NOTICE"

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 18th day of December, 1959, at Fairmount Grange Hall, Albany, Oragon, a special election will be held concerning the proposed annexation of the following described territory to the City of Albany, to-wit:

Beginning at a point at the intersection of the S. line of Quarry Rd. and the W. line of Spring Hill Rd.; thence Southerly along the W. line of Spring Hill Rd. to a point which is the intersection of the W. line of Ellsworth St. extended Northerly and the N. line of Spring Hill Rd.; thence Southerly along the W. line of Ellsworth St. extended to the city limits line in the center line of the Willamette River; thence Westerly along the center line of said river to a point that is on the E. line of Gibson Hill Rd. extended Southerly; thence Northerly along the E. line of Gibson Hill Rd. extended, to the intersection of the N. line of Walnut Rd. and the E. line of Gibson Hill Rd.; thence Westerly along the N. line of Gibson Hill Rd.; thence Northerly along the E. line of Gibson Hill Rd. and the S. line of Laurel Heights Drive; thence Easterly along the S. line of Laurel Heights
Drive extended Easterly to the S. line of Quarry Rd.; thence Easterly along the S. line of Quarry Rd. to the intersection of the S. line of Quarry Rd. and the W. line of Spring Hill Rd.; being the point of beginning.

which election will be held at 8 o'clock in the morning and will continue until 8 o'clock in the afternoon Pacific Standard Time of the said day.

Registered voters in said territory are invited to vote upon the proposed annexation.

Section 6: PURPOSE OF ELECTION

At the said special election, the proposed annexation of the territory described below shall be submitted to the legal voters of the said territory for their adoption or rejection as hereinafter set forth in Section 7.

Section 7: SAMPLE BALLOT

The ballot title of the proposed annexation submitted to the registered voters of the said territory shall be as follows:

"PROPOSAL TO ANNEX AREA NO. 5, A PORTION OF NORTH ALBANY, BENTON COUNTY, OREGON, TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON.

AN ACT to annex the following described territory to the City of Albany:

Beginning at a point at the intersection of the S. line of Quarry Rd. and the W. line of Spring Hill Rd.; thence Southerly along the W.line of Spring Hill Rd. to a point which is the intersection of the W. line of Ellsworth St. extended Northerly and the N. line of Spring Hill Rd.; thence Southerly along the W. line of Ellsworth St. extended to the city limits line in the center line of Willamette River; thence Westerly along the center line of said river to a point that is on the E. line of Gibson Hill Rd. extended, to the intersection of the N. line of Walnut Rd. and the E. line of Gibson Hill Rd.; thence Westerly along the N. line of Gibson Hill Rd.; thence Northerly along the E. line of Gibson Hill Rd. and the S. line of Laurel Heights Drive; thence Easterly along the S. line of Laurel Heights Drive extended Easterly tothe S. line of Quarry Rd.; thence Easterly along the S. line of Quarry Rd. to the intersection of the S. line of Quarry Rd. and the W. line of Spring Hill Rd. being the point of beginning.
