AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE ASSESSMENTS AGAINST THE PROPERTY SPECIFICALLI BENEFITED BY THE 1961 GROUP I AND GROUP II STREET IMPROVEMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
