ORDINANCE NO. 3011

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF POSTS TO PREVENT VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ON SIDEWALKS AT THE SOUTH LINE OF THE ALLEY BETWEEN FIRST AVENUE AND WATER STREET AT THE INTERSECTION OF ELLSWORTH STREET IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: LOCATION OF POSTS TO BE ERECTED

There shall be erected posts along the south line of the alley between First Avenue and Water Street at the intersection of Ellsworth Street in the City of Albany, to prevent motor vehicular traffic from using any portion of the sidewalk from the said alley south to First Avenue.

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Inasmuch as the erection of posts to prevent vehicular traffic along the sidewalk in the above mentioned vicinity is necessary in order to preserve the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
