ORDINANCE NO. 3043

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT TOILET FACILITIES BE AVAILABLE DURING THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION OF A BUILDING WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: DEFINITION

The term "person as used in this ordinance shall mean and include any person or persons, firm or firms, corporation or corporations.

Section 2: TOILET FACILITIES REQUIRED DURING CONSTRUCTION

Before the construction of any building or structure is started a temporary water-flushed toilet or an approved chemical toilet shall be installed for the use of the workmen. This temporary toilet shall be maintained throughout the construction of the building or structure. If a water-flushed toilet is used, such toilet shall be connected to the sewer and tile pipe without a vent may be used for the installation. The person in whose name the building permit for the construction has been issued is charged with the requirement for providing the temporary water-flushed toilet or approved chemical toilet and is charged with the requirement of maintenance of said facilities during the course of construction.

Section 3: PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of Section 2 of this ordinance in that no temporary water-flushed toilet or an approved chemical toilet is provided during the course of construction of any building or structure shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and

Upon conviction, thereof, in the Municipal Court of the City of Albany, Oregon, shall pay a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
