AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE PRINSEN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON

WHEREAS, on the 24th day of October, 1962 at a regular Council meeting, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon did duly pass Ordinance No. 3028, wherein it was provided that a Public Hearing would be held on the 28th day of November, 1962, concerning the advisability of annexing an area described as the Prinsen Property to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon and

WHEREAS, the hearing was duly held on the 28th day of November, 1962, and at that time, the Council determined that the Notices of Hearing had been given as provided in the said Ordinance, and pursuant to the terms of ORS 222.120, and

WHEREAS, the Council after the said hearing determined that the area described as the Prinsen Property to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon be annexed to the City of Albany, and the consent of the property owners having been filed giving their consent to the annexation,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described property be and is hereby annexed to the City of Albany, to wit:

Beginning at a point North 0°52'W 1167.54' from the NW Cor. of the Truett Davis DLC No. 38, T. 11 S., R. 4 W. of the W.M. in Linn County, Oregon; th N 89°06'E 471' to a 1/2" rod; th S 0°52'E 138.75 to a 3/4" pipe; th S 89°06'W 428.88' to a 3/4" pipe, th continuing S 89°06'W 42.12' to a point in the Old Pacific Highway which is S 0°52'E from the place of beginning; th N 0°52'W 138.75' to the place of beginning.

Section 2: That a copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the City Recorder and the number of this ordinance shall be noted on the official zoning map of the City of Albany.
