ORDINANCE NO. 3100

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING AN AREA SOUTH OF ALBANY AIRPORT AND ADJACENT TO U.S. HWY. 20 AND GOLDFISH FARM ROAD TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS on the 11th day of December, 1963, at a regular Council meeting, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, did duly pass Ordinance No. 3091 wherein it was provided that a public hearing would be held on the 8th day of January, 1964, concerning the advisability of annexing an area described as South of Albany Airport and Adjacent to U.S. Highway 20 and Goldfish Farm Road, Linn County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the hearing was duly held on the 8th day of January, 1964, and at that time the Council determined that the Notices of Hearing had been given as provided in the said Ordinance, and pursuant to the terms of ORS 222.110, 222.120 and 222.170, and

WHEREAS, the Council after said hearing determined that the area described as South of Albany Airport and adjacent to U.S. Highway 20 and Goldfish Farm Road, Linn County, Oregon, be annexed to the City of Albany, and the consent of the property owners having been filed giving their consent to the annexation,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described property be and is hereby annexed to the City of Albany, to-wit:

Beginning N. 89°56' W. 1059.96 ft. from the Northeast corner of DLC 48, T. 11 S., R. 3 W., W.M.; thence Sly. 1839.42 ft.; thence N. 89°56' W. 1106.46 ft.; thence Nly. 601.72 ft.; thence S. 89°56' E. 265.64 ft.; thence N. 1°25' W. 1242.50 ft. to the North line of said DLC 48; thence S. 89°59' W. 25 ft., more or less, to a point S. 945.45 ft. and S. 89°59' W. 416 ft. from the Southwest corner of DLC 39, T. 11, S., R. 3 W.; thence Nly 400.0 ft.; thence S. 89°59' W. 141.0 ft.; thence Nly 230.44 ft.; thence S. 89°59' W. 607.95 ft.; thence Sly. 330.44 ft.; thence S. 89°59' W. 20 right-of-way; thence S. 89°59' W. 325.05 ft.; thence Nly. 820.44 ft.; thence N. 89°59' E. 544.5 ft.; thence Nly 65.01 ft. to a point S. 89°59' W. 20 ch. from the Southwest corner of DLC 39; thence N. 89°59' E. 1120 ft.; thence S. 945.45 ft. to the North line of DLC 48; thence S. 89°54' E. along said North line 680 ft., more or less, to the place of beginning.

Section 2: That a copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the City Recorder and the number of this ordinance shall be noted on the official zoning map of the City of Albany.

<u>Section 3</u>: Whereas, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property herein described be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and should the same be annexed, that the City facilities by made available to this property, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
