

ORDINANCE NO. 3139

AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTION OF LANSING AVENUE EAST OF COX STREET

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did, by the adoption of Resolution No. 777 at the Council meeting held on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1964, set the hour as 7:15 p.m. o'clock on June 10, 1964 as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of Lansing Avenue, East of Cox Street, more particularly described in the said Resolution and did in the said Resolution direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law and in the said Resolution, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1964 was duly held and parties were given opportunity to be heard and Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

All that portion of Lansing Avenue East of Cox Street, more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Lansing Avenue East of East line of Cox Street, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon,

be and the same in hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany, Oregon.



