TITLE:

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2751, Section 37 thereof, as to reckless driving, by the addition of Section 11a prohibiting back in parking on public parking lots, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

Section 37 of Ordinance No. 2751 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 37: RECKLESS DRIVING. Any person who drives any vehicle upon a street carelessly and heedlessly in willful of wanton disregard of the rights or safety of others is guilty of reckless driving and, upon conviction, shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than one year or by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or both."

Section 2: AMENDMENT

Ordinance No. 2751 is amended by the addition of Section 11a to read as follows:

"Section lla: Method of Parking in Public Parking Lots. It shall be unlawful for any person to back into and leave parked a motor vehicle in a parking space on a public parking lot in the City of Albany."

Section 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance become immediately effective, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in full force immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
