ORDINANCE NO. 3191

AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALL OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 12, HAZELWOOD ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 854, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 14th day of April, 1965, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on May 12, 1965, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of all of the alley in Block 12, Hazelwood Addition, as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 12th day of May, 1965, was duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That all of the alley in Block 12, Hazelwood Addition to the City of Albany, more particularly described as follows:

All of the alley in Block 12, Hazelwood Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon,

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public alleyway in the City of Albany, Oregon.

Section 2: That the City of Albany does reserve an easement for utility purposes over the vacated alley and retains the right to go upon the premises and install, replace or repair sewers, water lines, or other public utilities.
