ORDINANCE NO. 3211

AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE ASSESSMENT AGAINST THE PROPERTY SPECIFICALLY BENEFITED BY THE COX CREEK TRUNK SEWER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
