ORDINANCE NO. 3218

AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE ASSESSMENTS AGAINST PROPERTY SPECIFICALLY BENEFITED BY THE REMOVAL OF NOXIOUS WEEDS AND VEGETATION, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 2303, PROVIDING FOR THE DOCKETING OF ASSESSMENTS AS CITY LIENS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Chief of the Fire Department, on behalf of the City of Albany, has previously inspected certain property within the City and has determined that a nuisance exists on certain property as defined in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2303, and notice was duly given as by law required for abatement of said nuisance by the owners of the properties hereinafter described and the owners of the properties did fail and neglect to abate said nuisance, and

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Albany, pursuant to the direction of Section 3 of Ordinance No. 2303 did cause to be removed and abated the nuisance on the property hereinafter described and did keep a complete record of the cost of labor and material used in connection with such removal and has reported the same to the City Council and the report having been found in order by the City Council and the costs deemed to be reasonable,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The report of the Chief of the Fire Department as to costs of removing the nuisance, is hereby adopted by the Council and shall be as follows:

Nuisance Abatement Costs	\$ 63.00
15% Administrative Costs	\$ 72.45
Total Costs	\$ 72.45

Section 2: There is hereby assessed against the individual pieces of property hereinafter described those sums of money set forth following the description of the property, said sums to be deemed as an assessment, for the removal of noxious weeds and vegetation and abatement of nuisance as provided in Ordinance No. 2303, of the City of Albany:
