

TITLE: An Ordinance providing for the date and manner of holding a special election in the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 8th day of November, 1966, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of the City of Albany for their adoption or rejection a proposed charter amendment to the City as follows:

- a) Amending Section 3 of the Charter to include all property presently surrounded by incorporated area of the City of Albany
- b) Amending Section 11 concerning appointive officers of the City

and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: SPECIAL ELECTION CALLED

In the manner provided by law and in this Ordinance and for the purposes set forth herein, a special election shall be held in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, on the 8th day of November, 1966. There is a state wide general election being held in the State of Oregon and in the City of Albany and as a part thereof on the 8th day of November, 1966, this special election is called to be held concurrently therewith.

Section 2: PROPOSITIONS TO BE VOTED

At the election, there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Albany for their approval or rejection the following propositions:

Shall Sections 3 and 11 of the Charter of the City of Albany be amended as follows?

- a) Amendment by addition to Section 3 as follows:

"The City boundaries shall include all territory presently surrounded by incorporated areas of the City of Albany."

- b) Section 11 to read as follows:

"Section 11. Other officers and employees. The titles of appointive officers of the City shall be as designated by the Council. Any requirement that an appointive officer shall fill two or more appointive offices may be effected only by the Council."

Section 3: DESIGNATION OF POLLING PLACES, POLL BOOKS AND JUDGES

The regular polling places designated by the County Court of Linn County, Oregon, and each voting precinct in the City of Albany are hereby designated as the polling places for the special city election; the poll books adopted by the County Court of Linn County, Oregon, as the poll books for the state wide general election for the voting precincts in the City of Albany hereby are adopted as the poll books for the special city election; the judges and clerks of the election appointed by the County Court of Linn County, Oregon, to serve as the state wide general election are hereby designated as the judges and clerks of and for the special city election.

Section 4: HOURS OF ELECTION

The polls for the special city election shall be open in each of the voting precincts at the same hour, and shall be kept open at the same hours as the polls are opened and closed for the state wide general election to be held on the same day.

Section 5: NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice of this election shall be given by publication at least twice in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon. The first publication to be within thirty (30) days next preceding the date of the election. Notices of the election shall be posted for not less than

ten (10) days before the election in three (3) public places within the City. The notice in the newspaper and those posted in three (3) public places shall be in substantially the following form:

"NOTICE OF ELECTION"

"On the 8th day of November, 1966, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, from 8 o'clock a.m. until 8 o'clock p.m. a special election shall be held at which time the following measures shall be submitted to the voters for their approval or rejection:

'Shall the Charter of the City of Albany be amended as to Section 3 and 11 to read as follows?

a) Amendment by addition to Section 3 as follows:

The City boundaries shall include all territory presently surrounded by incorporated areas of the City of Albany.

b) Amending Section 11 to read as follows:

Section 11 Other Officers and Employees The titles of appointive officers of the City shall be as designated by the Council. Any requirement that an appointive officer shall fill two or more appointive offices may be effected only by the Council.'

The City and County precincts within the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, shall have uniform boundaries and the same election boards; The polling places in the City for the special City election shall be at the same places as provided by the County of Linn, State of Oregon, for the state wide general election to be held on the same day, that is, November 8, 1966, and such places as the election board as may legally adjourn.

The City Council, by Ordinance, has appointed the identical officers appointed by the County Court of Linn County, Oregon, for the state wide election as the judges and clerks of the special City election to serve in each of the polling places and respective precincts to which they are appointed by the County Court of Linn County, Oregon.

The City Recorder shall advertise and post or cause to be posted the notices required by this section. The notices of election required to be given by this Ordinance shall constitute the only notice necessary and all Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict herewith shall not apply to the notices required to be given of this election.

Section 6: BALLOT FORM

The following is the official form on which the questions shall be printed on the official ballot:

"Vote YES or NO, mark an X in the square for the answer voted for. Referred to the people by the City Council:

Shall the Charter of the City of Albany as to Section 3 be amended to read as follows?

'The City boundaries shall include all territory presently surrounded by incorporated areas of the City of Albany.'

VOTE YES or NO

Shall the Charter of the City of Albany be amended as to Section 11 thereof to read as follows?

'Section 11 Other Officers and Employees: The titles of appointive officers of the City of Albany shall be as designated by the Council. Any requirement that an appointive officer shall fill two or more appointive offices may be effected only by the Council.'

VOTE YES or NO

Section 7: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Inasmuch as it is necessary that this Ordinance become effective at the earliest practicable date so that the same may be submitted to the voters of the City of Albany at the state wide general election to be held November 8, 1966, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
