ORDINANCE NO. 3374

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2730, AS THE SAME PROVIDES FOR THE TIME OF HOLDING MUNICIPAL COURT IN THE CITY OF ALBANY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

Section 4 of Ordinance No. 2730 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4: TIME FOR HOLDING COURT.

The Municipal Judge shall establish by appropriate order a regular time for holding court session on not less than a weekly basis. In addition to the time established by order of the Court, Municipal Court may be held at such other times as the Judge shall deem necessary for the protective rights of a person charged with violations."

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

Whereas, the foregoing Ordinance is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
