TITLE: An Ordinance providing for the date and manner of holding a special election in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, on the 3rd day of April 1969, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of the Cit of Albany, Oregon, an act to provide for a special continuing five (5) year tax levy of \$318,091.00 per year outside the 6% limitation, beginning with the year 1969-70, to provide funds for mosquito control, salaries and payroll taxes, park maintenance, acquisition of property for parks and development thereof, railroad crossing protection, traffic signal construction, bridge construction, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

## Section 1: SPECIAL ELECTION CALLED.

That the proposition set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this Ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Albany, Oregon, at a special election to be held on the 3rd day of April, 1969.

## Section 2: PROPOSITION TO BE VOTED.

At the election, there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Albany, Oregon, for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

"Shall the City of Albany levy a special continuing five (5) year tax levy not to exceed \$318,091.00 per year outside the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon constitution, beginning with the tax year 1969-70 to provide funds for mosquito control, salaries and payroll taxes, park maintenance, acquisition of property for parks and development thereof, railroad crossing protection, traffic signal construction, and bridge construction?"

"The rate of levy deemed necessary to raise the above amount is estimated as follows:

For 1969-70	The sum \$2,81 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city.
For 1970-71	The sum of \$2.78 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city.
For 1971-72	The sum of \$2.68 per \$1,900.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city.

For 1972-73 The sum of \$2.57 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city.

For 1973-74 The sum of \$2.52 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city.

Section 3: DESIGNATION OF POLLING PLACES, POLL BOOKS AND JUDGES.

The polling places are hereby designated as follows:

Ward Two Lafayette School

The poll books shall be prepared by the Recorder of the City of Albany pursuant to the laws and ordinances of the City of Albany and the judges and clerks of said election shall be appointed by the City Recorder of the City of Albany and serve as judges and clerks at the special city election.

Section 4: HOURS OF ELECTION.

The polls for the special city election shall be kept open at the colling place from 8 o'clock a.m. un'il 30'clock n.m.

Section 5: NOTICE OF ELECTI N.

Notice of election shall be a went to publication twice in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Albany, Oregon, not more than twenty (20) days nor less than, ten (10) days before the election. Notice of election shall be posted for not less than ten (10) days before the election in three (3) public places within the city. The notice in the newspaper and those posted in three (3) public places shall be in substantially the following form:

## "NOTICE OF ELECTION"

On the 3rd day of April, 1969, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, from 8 o'clock a.m. until 8 o'clock p.m., a special election shall be held at which time the following proposition shall be submitted to the voters for their approval:

'Shall the City of Albany levy a special continuing five (5) year tax levy not to exceed \$318,091.00 per year outside the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon constitution, beginning with the tax year 1969-70 to provide funds for mosquito control, salaries and payroll taxes, park maintenance, acquisition of property for parks and development thereof, railroad crossing protection, traffic signal construction and bridge construction?'

The rate of levy deemed necessary to raise the above amount is estimated as follows:

- For 1969-70 The sum of \$2.81 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city.
- For 1970-71 The sum of \$2.78 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city.
- For 1971-72 The sum of \$2.68 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city.
- For 1972-73 The sum of \$2.57 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city.
- For 1973-74 The sum of \$2.52 per \$1,000.00 of the true cash value of taxable property within the city.
