TITLE:

AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 5.08.120 TO THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE LIMITING LOUD NOISES AND SPEAKING DEVICES BY PEDDLERS.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: SECTION ADDED.

Section 5.08.120 is hereby added to the Albany Municipal Code to read as follows:

"Section 5.08.120. Loud Noises and Speaking Devices.
No peddler, nor any person on his behalf, shall shout,
make any outcry, ring any bell or use any sound device
where sound of sufficient volume is emitted or produced
therefrom to be capable of being heard at a
distance of more than 200 feet upon the streets, alleys,
avenues, parks or other public places for the purpose
of attracting attention to any goods, wares or merchandise
which a peddler proposes to sell. For the purpose of
determining whether or not the volume is sufficient to be
heard from a distance of more than 200 feet, the judgment of a police officer exercising good faith shall
be deemed conclusive."
