## ORDINANCE NO. 3567

AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALLEY IN BLOCK SIX, HAZELWOOD ADDITION, RUNNING EAST AND WEST, BETWEEN LINCOLN AND BROADWAY STREETS RESERVING A. TWELVE FOOT UTILITY EASEMENT

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1310, City of Albany Resolutions, at the council meeting held on the 28th day of April, 1971, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on June 9, 1971, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of an alley in Block Six, Hazel-wood Addition, running east and west between Lincoln and Broadway Streets, Reserving a twelve foot utility easement, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 9th day of June, 1971, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed, now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the alley in Block Six, Hazelwood Addition, running East and West, between Lincoln and Broadway Street; RESERVING a 12 ft. utility easement for maintenance of sanitary sewer line, be and the same is hereby vacated.
