# AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING AN AREA NORTH OF GRAND PRAIRIE ROAD, ADTACENT TO EAST OF PERRYWINKLE CREEK TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 

WHEREAS, on the 10 th day of March, 1971, at a regular Council meeting, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, did duly pass Ordinance No. 3538, wherein it was provided that a public hearing would be held on the 28 th day of April, 1971, concerning the advisability of annexing the area described herein, an area north of Grand Prairie Road, adjacent to east of Perrywinkle Creek, to the City of Albany, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the hearing was duly held on the 28th day of April, 1971, and at that time the Council determined that the Notices of Hearing had been given as provided in the said Ordinance, and pursuant to the terms of ORS 222.111, 222.120 and 222.170, and

WHEREAS, the Council after said hearing determined that the area described as North of Grand Prairie Road, adjacent to East of Perrywinkle Creek, hereinafter described, be annexed to the City of Albany, and the consent of the property owners having been filed giving their consent to the annexation,

## THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described property be and is hereby annexed to the City of Albany, to-wit:

Pareel. I: Pegimming at Nowhwest comen of tract deed to Fred and Stelna May hoflich and reconded November 8,1955 in Book 240 , page it, of Lim County Deed Reconds, which conner is Nonth $60^{\circ}$ West 369 feet and North $4030{ }^{\circ}$ Last 500 feet from Southeast comen of Lot 1 l of the Jason Wheolen's llanc Fam in Timm County, Oregon; and ruming thence Nowth 12045 ' East purallel to the West line of said fot $1 \lambda$, a distance of 71.7 feet to the North line of said Lot, thence East on said line 70 fect to the Southwest comen of Doemplen truet as mecomed barch 9, 1942 in liook 1.57 , page 497, boed Reconds; thener Nomthenly along the West line of sajd taact 171.6 feet to the houthest comer thereof, thence Easterly parallel to the South line of Leander C. Bunkhart Donation Land Claim No. 50 in tomship 11. South, Range 3 Nest of Willamette Neridian, a distance of 663.64 feet to a $5 / 8$ inch rod which is Nowth $89^{\circ} 5 \lambda$, West 352.10 feet from the Bast line of said claim; thence South 1039: East paxulkel to the West line of Anderson Cox Donation Land Claim No. 49 in said Township and Range, a distance of 5.2 .67 feet to a $5 / 8$ inch rod on the North line of Jot 8 , in Jason Weelen's Home Fama; thence West on the North line of Lots 8 and 9 a distance of 591.7 feet to a point 64.2 feet Nest of the Northmest commen of Lot 9, thence South $4 \mathrm{O}^{\circ} 0^{\prime}$ West parallel to the West line of Lot 9 , a distance of 385 feet to the North line of Hoflich tract; thence North $66^{\circ}$ West along said line 297 feet to the point of beginning.

As a R-6 Residential Zone
Section 2: That a copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the City Recorder and the number of the ordinance shall be noted on the official zoning map of the City of Albany.

Section 3: WHEREAS, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property herein described be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and that the City facilities be made available to this property; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
