AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE ASSESSMENTS AGAINST PROPERTIES SPECIFICALLY BENEFITED BY SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENT: INTERCEPTOR SEWER ALONG GRAND PRAIRIE FROM COLUMBUS STREET TO DAVIDSON STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

RECITALS:

- 1. The sewer assessment as referred to in this ordinance and previous resolutions and ordinances is: Interceptor Sewer Grand Prairie from Columbus to Waverly (SS-1971-10)
- 2. Preliminary resolutions and ordinances prescribing the manner and extent of the improvement are set forth in Resolution Nos. 1322, 1334 and in Ordinance No. 2864.
- 3. The assessments set forth in the following ordinance are based upon the request and recommendation of the City Engineer in compliance with Ordinance No. 2864.

Section 1: COST
