ORDINANCE NO. $\quad 3609$
AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO DISPENSE WITH AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALbANY, OREGON, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ORS SFCTIONS 222.111, 222.120 AND 222.170, REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF AN AREA LOCATED AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF ERMINE AND 31ST AVENUE, CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, SETTING A TIME FOR PUBLIC HFARING ON THE SAME AND DECIARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, 100 per cent of the owners of the property which is the subject matter of this annexation have petitioned and requested the City of Albany to annex the area hereinafter described to the City, and the same being contiguous and in all respects qualifying under present statuies for annexation, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Albany that a public hearing be held at the earliest possible date to consider objections to the annexation of the property herein described.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

## Section 1: DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

That an election within the City of Albany regarding the annexation of the following described property to-wit:

Boginning at a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ iron rod, said rod being the Southeast comer of Davidson Park Subcirasion in Section 17, Mownshipll Soutin, Range 3 West of the Willamette Moridian in Jinn County, Oregon; running thonce North $13^{\circ} 17^{\prime} 30^{\prime \prime}$ East along the Eastaly houndary of said subdivision a distance of 813.29 feet; thence South $31^{\circ}$ 31' $35^{\prime \prime}$ East 81.00 feet; thence South $42^{\circ} 57^{\prime} 15^{\prime \prime}$ East: 290.00 feet to the Westerly boundary of a road right-of-way; thence South $13^{\circ} 19^{\prime} 30^{\prime \prime}$ West 542.58 feet along said right-of-way; thonce Noth $86^{\circ} 38^{\prime}$ West 302.74 feet to the true place of begimine, fleo lexcept the Southorly 1 foot of oven width thereof, AJSO begiming at the Souiheost comer of Javidson Park Subdivision in Section 17, Township 11 South, Range 3 West of tho Vjllametto Meridian in Lim County, Oregon, said comer being on the Southerly lime of Jason Wheeler Iome Form Tracts; thence South $86^{\circ} 39^{\prime}$ East along said Southerly line 297.98 feet to the Northeast corner of the Fourth Addition to Vista Iomes, a recorded subdivision, Limn County, Oregon; thence South $1^{\circ} 36^{\prime}$. East, l foot, more or less, to a point on the Wor therly line of East 31 st Avenue; thence Jorth $86^{\circ} 39^{\prime}$ West along the LIortherly line of East 31 st Avenue to a point which bears South $13^{\circ} 1.7^{\prime} 30^{\prime \prime}$ West from the Southeast corner of said Davidson Park; therce North $13^{\circ} 17^{\prime} 30^{\prime \prime}$ East 1 foot, more or less, to the point of beginning. SAVE AND WXCEPT that portion of the above described tract of land lying within the boundaries of public roads and highways.

That there shall be a public hearing as to the advisability of annexing the property described in Section 1 to the City of Albany on the 22 nd day of _March__1972, at 7:15 p.m. o'clock, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to give notice of sald public hearing by publishing in a newspaper of general circulation, published in the said City once a week for two (2) successive and consecutive weeks and by posting in four (4) public places, a notice setting forth the time and place of said hearing and the description of the property to be considered for annexation and the purpose for which the hearing is held.

## Section 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the proyerty described herein be disposed of at the carliest possible moment, and, should the same be annexed, that the City facilities be made available to this property, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon Its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
