ORDINANCE NO. 3631

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO DISPENSE WITH AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ORS SECTIONS 222.111, 222.120 AND 222.170, REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF AN AREA ON THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF INTERSTATE 5 AND HIGHWAY 34, SETTING A TIME FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, 100 per cent of the owners of the property which is the subject matter of this annexation have petitioned and requested the City of Albany to annex the area hereinafter described to the City, and the same being contiguous and in all respects qualifying under present statutes for annexation, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Albany that a public hearing be held at the earliest possible date to consider objections to the annexation of the property herein described.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

That an election within the City of Albany regarding the annexation of the following described property to-wit:

The following described real property situated in the County of Linn and State of Oregon, to-wit:

TRACT I: The West one-half of the East one-half of the Southwest one-quarter of Section 4, Township 12 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Linn County, Oregon; Except that portion situated in the County Road conveyed to Linn County by deed recorded December 28, 1953, in Book 235, page 584, Deed Records; Also Except that portion within Interstate 5 acquired by the State of Oregon by condemnation in the State Circuit Court, Case No. 28535, entitled State of Oregon va. Oscar W. Olson, et al, final decree entered April 30, 1959; and also Except that portion conveyed to the State of Oregon, by and through its State Highway Commission, by deed recorded February 24, 1967, in Book 322, page 47, Deed Records.

TRACT III: Beginning at the Southwest corner of that tract conveyed to the State of Oregon by deed recorded January 7, 1966, in Book 314, page 496, Deed Records, said point being South 89 40' East, 1024.87 feet South 0°20' West 91.76 feet, South 1°10'45" East 5.13 feet, North 30°37'49" West 19.70 feet and North 89 40' West 268.43 feet from the quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 5, in Township 12 South, Range 3 West of the Willemette Meridian, Linn County, Oregon; thence North

E9°40' West 200 feet along the South edge of the right of way line for the Lebanen-Corvallia Highway No. 34, as conveyed to the State of Oregon by feed recorded Catober 4, 1955 in Dack 319, page 532, Eeed Decorde, Lina County, Gregon, to the true place of beginning; thence Ecuth 1°14 5' East 250 feet; thence Easterly 200 feet on a line parallel to the South edge of the right of way of Lebanen-Corvallia Highway No. 34, as conveyed in Dack 319, page 532, Dack Records; thence North 1°10'55" Nest 75 feet to the Scuthcast corner of that tract conveyed to Culf Cal Corporation by feed recorded July 22, 1938, in Dack 332, page 193, Deed Records; thence Vesterly along the South line of said Culf Cal tract 150 feet to the Scuthwest corner of said tract; thence North 1°10'55" Year 175 feet along the Vest line of said Culf Cal tract to the South edge of said Lebanen-Corvallie Highway; thence North 59°40' Vest 50 feet along the South edge of said Highway; thence North 59°40' Vest 50 feet along the

ETHER IV: Deciming at a 3/0 inch ison pipe marking the Southwesterly corner of that treet of land conveyed to Shall Gil Gerpany by deed recorded in Volume 310, page 459, Lina Geunty records of deeds, which is recorded as bearing South 69 40' Doot 1083.87 feet and South 0'80' West 91.75 feet and South 1'10'45' Enet 151.34 feet and Herth ES'53'30' West 278.77 feet from the quarter corner between Seatlans 4 and 5, Sounship 12 South, Range 3 West of the Villemette Heridden, Lina County, Gregon, and running thence from the true place of beginning, North 1'10'45 West 149.98 feet along the Westerly boundary line of said Shall Gil Geograpy treet to the Herthwesterly sowner of said tract; thence South 69'40' East 90.00 feet along the Herthorly boundary line of said Shall Gil Geograpy tract to a point; thence South 1'10'45' East 154.22 feet parallel to the Mesterly boundary line of said tract; thence Herth 66'59'20' West 90.21 feet along said Southerly boundary line to the place of beginning.

Altman, Co-partners, deing business as WA Company, by John Cale Ematsim in doed recorded July 22, 1958, in Each 332, page 197, Bood Records; Also emcept that pertien conveyed to Eripp & Fripp, a partnership compining of Reimsy V. Eripp and Russell W. Fripp, by John Cale Swatchs in doed recorded January 7, 1956, in Each 314, page 498, Doed Records; Also except that parties conveyed to G. Robert Altman, H. D. Tibbale, and N. L. Cidright, by John Cale Swatchs, by deed recorded June 4, 1971, in Each 16, page 203, Hierofilm Records.

Ends VI: A parcel of land lying in the Northwest quarter of the Scatiment quarter of Section 4, Commanie 12 South, Range 3 West of the Milliamette Meridian, Man County, Greger, and being a pertien of that property Coccribed in those deeds to State of Gregor, by and through its Boate Mighay Commission, recorded in Rech 314, page 495; in Each 319, page 522 and in Parcel 3 of Each 259, page 652, all of Man Germay record of records, the said parcel being that pertien of maid property lying Southerly of the following decembed line:
Logimains at a point opposite and Co feet Southerly of Engineer's Station 157750 on the convertion of the releasted Corvellia-Laboner Mighay; thence Enstealy in a straight line to a point opposite and 160 feet Southerly of Engineer's Station 360400 on said centerline; themse Ensteally parallel to said conterline to the East line of maid Hertimest quarter of the Southmest quarter. Section 2: HEARING

That there shall be a public hearing as to the advisability of annexing the property described in Section 1 to the City of Albany, on the 28th day of June 1972, at 7:15 p.m. o'clock, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to give notice of said public hearing by publishing in a newspaper of general circulation, published in the said City once a week for two (2) successive and consecutive weeks and by posting in four (4) public places, a notice setting forth the time and place of said hearing and the description of the property to be considered for annexation and the purpose for which the hearing is held.

Section 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and, should the same be annexed, that the City facilities be made available to this property, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
