## ORDINANCE NO. 3650

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A SEWER EASEMENT FOR INTERCEPTOR TRUNK LINE DIAGONALLY THROUGH CENTER OF LAFAYETTE STREET TO MADISON . STREET IN BLOCK 123 HACKLEMAN'S ADDITION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1420, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 14th day of June , 19 72, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on the 26th day of July , 19 72, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of sewer easement for Interceptor Trunk Line running diagonally through center of Lafayette Street to Madison Street in Blook 123, Hackleman's Addition as recorded in Linn County Deed Records, Book 261, Page 762 and Book 262, Page I herein described and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 26th day of July , 1972, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> That a sewer easement for the Interceptor Trunk Line running diagonally through center of Lafayette Street to Madison Street in Block 123, Hackleman's Addition as recorded in Linn County Deed Records, Book 261, Page 762 and Book 262, Page and described as follows:

Beginning at a point that is 312 feet North of the Southwest corner of Block 123, Hackleman's Addition to the City of Albany, said point being the true point of beginning of this easement; and running thence East 276 feet, more or less, to the East line of Block 123, in said Hackleman's Addition. Subject to: Grantee's use and occupancy of the premises shall at all times be in compliance with existing laws, rules and regulations, and if City should ever abandon this sewer, grantors are to be notified and discharge easement by quit claim deed.

be and the same is hereby vacated.
