## CRDINANCE NO. 3663

TITEP:
AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE DEFERRE.L OF SPECTAL ASSESSMENTS FOR STREET, CURB AND GUERT, STE PRODRAINS AND RELATED JMEROVEMENTS AS DFFIN PROERNY ONER IS A SENIOR CITIZEN AS DEFINED HEREIN AND OHERNISE QUALINE PMERGENCY MHS ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLONS:

## Section 1: PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to permit qualified serior ditizens to have deferred the special assessments that wa be levied against tineir residences for street, curb and
jutter, storm drains and related improvements. jutter, storm drains and related improvements.
Section 2: SENIOR CITIZEN DEFINED
A senior citizen is one who is 65 years of age or more on or before the lst day of January of the year in which the assessment in question is to be levied.

Section 3: QURLIFICATION OF SENIOR CITIZENS
To qualify for the senior citizens assessment deferral program:
(a) The propcrty to be assessed must be owned by a senior citizen or if owned by a husband and wife, then only one of then needs to be a senior citizen.
(b) The property to be assessed must be the residence of the senior citizen.
(c) The senior citizen shali have an income from all scurces not to exceed THREE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLTHRS ( $\$ 3,600.00$ ), and if he is married then their juint income shall not exceed FOUR THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED DOLJARS ( $\$ 4,100.00$ ), and further not to exceed an increase of more thar FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS ( $\$ 400.00$ ) for each additional
cependerit that is living with them during the calendar cependert that is living with them during the calendar year preceding the one in which the assessment is to be
levied.

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Section 4: DEFERRAL OF ASSESSMENT TC THE EXTENT MIAAT FLGND ARE
A quailified senior citizen may choose to have aeferred the special assessment for street, curb and gitter, storm arains na related improvements that are to be levied acainst fis zesicence. Such assessment shall bear interes at the rate of seven percent (7s) per anmun from the date that $1 t$ le led against weskerce and mil paid and shall become due when the procerty ceases to be the of the sale or rental of the sale or citizen and his spouse or for any other reason whatsoever

## Section 5: FINANCTNG OF PLAN

For the purpose of financing this plan, there is herebry reserved and comitted not to exceed twenty percent (20\%) of the ancommitted assets of the improvement projects fund. Senicr citizen assessmen derexrals will se granced sp the cily on a first cone irst serve basis during each year to the extant that funds a vailable from the source hereinabove set forth.
Section 6: NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OE DEFERRED ASSESSMENES
The City Recorder is authorized and directed after the initiation of a street improvement project, curb and gutter, storm drains and related improvements and upon the mailing of the engineer's estimate of cost of a project to include therewith a written notice advising all persons whom might be affected by this plan of its terms and provisions.

## Section 7: APPLICATION FOR SENIOR CETIZEN DEEERRL

A senior citizen may make application for serior citizens assessment deferral on a project affecting rim at any time afte: the engineer's estimate of cost has bean mailed but in no event later than the time fixed for appication to pay assessmerits and instalinsnts. uch appiication for senior citizens street assessments deferrisnt shall be filed on a form to be provided by the City lecorder.

## Section 8: INVESTIGATION OF STATUS OF LAND AND SENIOR CImzens

As frequently as appears appropriate the stafi shall roview the County Records relating to deferred special assessments and shall also make swoh Investigations as appear appropriate to learr of any other materiel changes in the status of the use of the subject land. The City Recorder shall also have authority to reguire incomo reports from participating senior citizens at least annaliy. Failure of a senior citizen enfoying a deferred street, curb anci gutter, storm drain or related improvements assessment status to furnish
information as required by the city Recorder shall result in loss off deferment and in such case such assessment shall be paid on the same schedule as though no senior citizen deferred street assessment status had been granted.
Section 9: assessment to be a LIEN
Any special assessment that is deferred by the terms of this ordinance shall become a lien on the land just as thought wis ozaina.ces had not been adopted. When such assessment becomes due by the terms of section 4 of this ordinance, it may be enforced and collected as provided in state law for the collection of assessments or by any other means provided by law.
Section 10: Election
A qualified senior citizen who elects to have a special assessment deferred pursuant to the provisions of this ordinance, shall enter into a contract to be prepared by the City Attorney.
Section 11: ANMURL REPORT OF COUNCIL
The City Manager is hereby directed to prepare an annual report of the city's experiences under this ordinance, including the cost thissof, and any recommendations for change and present the say: to the City council at its first regular meeting in February of each year.
Section 12: Emergency clause
That inasmuch as it is deemed necessary for the pubic health, peace and safety of the citizens of the city of Albany, that the provisions shall be immediately operative; it is hereby declared that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall be in
Enif force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and Jul force and effect
