## ORDINANCE NO. \_\_3680

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FAIR HOUSING ACT IN THE CITY OF ALBANY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The following enumerated fair housing laws of Oregon as heretofore or hereafter amended, are adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance:

O.R.S. 659.031 and O.R.S. 659.033

<u>Section 2</u>. A person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by imprisonment for a period not to exceed 30 days, or by a fine not to exceed \$500 or by both.

<u>Section 3</u>. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
