

ORDINANCE NO 3705

TITLE: An Ordinance Adopting a Supplemental Budget for 1972-73 and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Albany, Linn County and Benton County, State of Oregon does hereby adopt the Revenue Sharing Supplemental Budget with amounts appropriated as hereinafter set forth having held its public hearing on the 9th day of May, 1973 to afford interested persons an opportunity to be heard.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

A public hearing has been set for this meeting on the Supplemental Budget to cover the expenditures of general revenue sharing monies for this current budget year.

Very little of the money will actually be expended before the end of this current fiscal year, however, and it will therefore be re-budgeted in the budget to be submitted this coming week.
