

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE WITHDRAWING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY HERETO-
FORE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF ALBANY FROM THE Albany
Rural Fire Protection DISTRICT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

RECITALS: Certain real property in the territory described
below was annexed to the city of Albany by Ordinance
No. 3748, 3752 ; and

Whereas, the territory described below is located within
the boundaries of the Albany Rural Fire Protection district;
and

Whereas, pursuant to Ordinance No. _____, the City
Council of the city of Albany held a public hearing for
the purpose of hearing any objections to the withdrawal
of the property mentioned from the public service district
mentioned; now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: WITHDRAWAL

The City Council of the city of Albany determines that
the following described territory within the boundaries of the
Albany Rural Fire Protection district shall be, upon the effective
date of this Ordinance, withdrawn from the Albany Rural Fire
Protection district.

(Description of territory)

Section 2: ASSUMPTION OF OBLIGATION.

The city hereby elects to assume obligations of the
withdrawn territory and be liable to the district for the amount
of taxes which would be extended by the district each year against
the property in the part withdrawn if the withdrawal had not taken
place.

Section 3: Emergency Clause

Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation
of the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is
hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect
immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
