AN ORDINMNCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3672, SEGREGATING THE LIEN OF AMOS HEISTER AND J.M. BROWN ON PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS ST-72-25, 16TH AVENUE - CRITTENDEN TO GALE AND DECIARING AN EMERGENCY.
