AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALL STREETS IN THE RUITER'S ADDITION SOUTH OF THE SOUTH LINE OF QUEEN AVENUE (Attached Description).

Vacation of all streets in the Ruiter's Addition south of the south line of Queen Avenue to wit:

Calapooia Street from south line of Queen South to terminus;
Vine Street from south line of Queen south to terminus except that portion lying within the State of Oregon R/W of Pacific Boulevard;
16th Avenue (now knownas 19th Avenue) from Vine Street to Calapooia;
17th Avenue (Now known as 20th Avenue) from Vine Street to Calapooia;

All property adjacent to these streets are under one ownership or surrounded by the Santiam Albany Canal or the Southern Pacific Transportation Co. right-of-way.
