ORDINANCE NO. 3843

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.08.030 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE AS THE SAME PERTAINS TO SEWER USER CHARGES ESTABLISHING A SURCHARGE OF\$2.00 PER MONTH FOR A PERIOD OF TEN YEARS IN CERTAIN AREAS WITHIN THE CITY AND LIMITING THE USE OF THE \$2.00 SURCHARGE TO SEPARATION OF STORM AND SANITARY WASTES IN THOSE AREAS.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That 10.08.030 (b₁) of the Albany Municipal Code is hereby repealed. Section 2: That Section 10.08.030 of the Albany Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding sub-paragraph (c) to read as follows:

"(c) Surcharge established: In addition to the rates established in (a) and (b) of this schedule there shall be a \$2.00 per month surcharge per dwelling unit, multiple family dwelling unit, mobile home and trailer unit and commercial unit which shall be charged in certain areas as described within Exhibit "A" within the City in which there is not existing a separation of sanitary sewer waste and storm water waste.

EXCEPTION: In the case of a home occupation located in a residential area, only a single \$2.00 monthly surcharge shall be collected where no more than two extra plumbing fixtures have been installed for use by the home occupation. Such exception shall be made only after application in writing to the Finance Office and verification by the Building Department.

Said surcharge shall continue for period of ten years. The surcharge herein established shall be used for the purpose of separating the storm sewer water and sanitary sewage waste within the areas described in Exhibit "A". "

Section 3: Effective Date. Inasmuch as it is in the interest of the people of the City of Albany that the effective date of this ordinance be established as the 9th day of April, 1975, it is hereby declared that this ordinance shall be in full force and effective upon the same day of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
