## ORDINANCE NO. 4000

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING AND NOTICE THEREOF TO CONSIDER WITHDRAWING CERTAIN ANNEXED TERRITORY FROM THE ALBANY RURAL FIRE DISTRICT.

RECITALS: WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Albany and the territory annexed by Ordinances No. 3977, No. 3993, and No. that such territory be withdrawn from the Albany Rural Fire District; and

> WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Albany desires to obtain further citizens' opinion on the subject of withdrawal as directed by state law to obtain such opinion; now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: PUBLIC HEARING.

A public hearing on the question of withdrawing annexed territory from the Albany Rural Fire District shall be held on the <u>23rd</u> day of <u>March</u>, 1977, at 7:15 o'clock p.m. at the <u>City</u> Hall of the <u>City</u> of Albany.

Section 2: NOTICE.

The City Recorder shall cause notice of the hearing to be published once each week for two (2) successive weeks prior to the day of the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the city. The City Recorder shall also cause notice of this hearing to be posted in four (4) public places within the city for a like period of time.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE: WHEREAS it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of withdrawing certain annexed territory from the Albany Rural Fire District be disposed of at the earliest possible moment; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
