ORDINANCE NO. 4001

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS OF THE STATE OF OREGON ENACTED BY THE 1975 OREGON LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: ADOPTION OF 1975 MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS.

Chapter 13.04 of the Albany Municipal Code is amended by the addition of Section 13.04050 to read as follows:

"AMENDMENT -- ADOPTION OF 1975 Motor Vehicle Laws. Violation of provisions in Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapters 481, 482, 483, 484, 485 and 487 as now or hereafter constituted shall be an offense against this city and prosecution and trial thereunder shall be as provided therein."

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

Whereas, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany that this ordinance become effective at the earliest possible time, therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
