ORDINANCE NO. 4134

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 1978-79 BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY, LEVYING TAXES, MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE SEPARATE FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1: The Albany City Council hereby adopts the budget approved by the budget committee of the City of Albany, Oregon on April 19, 1978, now on file in the office of the Albany City Recorder.
- Section 2: The Albany City Council hereby levies the taxes provided for in the budget adopted in Paragraph 1 of this ordinance in the aggregate amount of \$1,020,677 and that these taxes are hereby levied upon all taxable property within the City of Albany, as of 1:00 a.m., January 1, 1978.
- Section 3: The amounts for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978, and for the purposes shown below are hereby appropriated as follows: (see attachments)
- Section 4: The City Recorder will certify to the County Clerk and County Assessor, the tax levy made by this ordinance and shall file with them a copy of the budget as finally adopted.
- Section 5: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
