ORDINANCE NO. 4171

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.36 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 13.36.180 MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO PARK A MOTOR VEHICLE ON A PUBLIC STREET AND OCCUPY THE SAME FOR SLEEPING OR HOUSEKEEPING PURPOSES FOR A PERIOD OF MORE THAN EIGHT (8) HOURS.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Albany Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of section 13.36.180 to read as follows:

"Section 13.36.180 Motor Vehicle Use for Sleeping or Housekeeping Purposes Prohibited. It is unlawful, within the City limits, for any person to use a motor vehicle parked on a public street, alley or other public place or tract of land in the City for sleeping or housekeeping purposes for a period of more than eight (8) hours. A special permit for use of said motor vehicle for sleeping or housekeeping purposes may be granted upon application as for special permits issued for use of trailors outside of mobile home parks under provisions of Albany Municipal Code Section 18.20.110."
