#### Abstract

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A CHARGE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 12.14 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE IN LIEU OF ASSESSMENT SAID PROPERTY BEING DESCRIBED AS TAX LOT 11-3W-8CB-102 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1:
A charge is hereby levied against the following described property:

| Beginning at a point whigh is 991.26 fect North $0^{\circ} 27156^{\prime \prime}$ West and 440 .15 feet South $89^{\prime \prime} 48^{\prime \prime} 36^{\prime \prime}$ West from the Southeast corner of Abram Hackleman DLC 62 in Section 8 , Township 11 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian, Linn County, Oregon, and rynning thence North $00^{\circ} 30^{\prime} 49^{\prime \prime}$ West $506.8^{4}$ feet; thence North $0^{\circ} 27^{\prime} 5^{\prime \prime}$ West 8.16 feet; thence South $89^{\circ} 48^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime}$ West 248.73 feet to the East right-of-way line of the Periwinkle Creek; thence South $0^{\circ}{ }^{\prime} 6^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime}$ East along said East line 514.99 feet; thence North $89^{\circ} 48^{\prime \prime} 36^{\prime \prime}$ East 250.94 feet to the point of beginning. |
