TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE \#4274, WHICH ESTABLISHED TIE-DOWN FEES FOR AIRPLANES UPON AIRPORT PROPERTY AND ESTABLISHING FUEL FLOWAGE FEES TO BE PAID FOR AVIATION FUEL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance \#4274 is hereby amended to read as follows:
There is hereby established a fee of FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00) per airplane tied down in unpaved areas for the use of tie-down facilities at the City of Albany Airport.

There is hereby established a fee of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) per airplane tied down in paved areas for the use of tie-down facilities at the City of Albany Airport.

These fees are established on a monthly basis and shall be paid in advance on or before the first day of each month. These fees apply only to those areas that are not under lease to fixed base operators at the airport. Payment of these tie-down fees shall not make the City liable for any damages to persons or property from the use of the tie-down areas.

There is hereby established a fee of TWO DOLLARS (\$2.00) per night per airplane for an airplane which does not have an assigned tie-down space but ties down on an overnight basis at the City of Albany Airport. This fee applies only to those areas that are not under lease to fixed base operators at the airport. Payment of this fee shall not make the City liable for any damages to persons or property from the use of the tiedown areas.

Section 2: These tie-down fees will be effective November 1, 1979.
Section 3: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
