## ORDINANCE NO. 4372

TITLE:

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 1980-81 BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY, LEVYING TAXES, MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE SEPARATE FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1: The Albany City Council hereby adopts the budget, attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance by this reference, approved by the Budget Committee of the City of Albany, Oregon on March 19, 1980, now on file in the office of the Albany City Recorder.
- Section 2: The Albany City Council hereby levies the taxes provided for in the budget adopted in Paragraph 1 of this ordinance in the aggregate amount of \$3,818,958 and that these taxes are hereby levied upon all taxable property within the City of Albany for fiscal year 1980-81.
- Section 3: The City Recorder will certify to the County Clerk and County Assessor the tax levy made by this ordinance and shall file with them a copy of the budget as finally adopted.
- Section 4: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
