ORDINANCE NO. 4427

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A PERMIT FOR USE OF SIDEWALK AS SIDEWALK CAFE AT 225 BROADALBIN STREET SW, PROVIDING FOR REVIEW OF THE PERMIT IN THREE MONTHS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Not withstanding the provisions of Chapter 7.68, it is hereby granted to the business known as Cheese & Crackers at 225 Broadalbin Street SW, Albany, Oregon, a permit for the use of a sidewalk adjoining the premises as a sidewalk cafe. This permit limits the use of the sidewalk to a distance of three feet from the face of the existing building.
- <u>Section 2.</u> This permit shall be reviewed by the City Council three months after its effective date; and unless specifically renewed at that time, the permit herein granted shall terminate four months from its effective date.
- Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
