ORDINANCE NO. 4456

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTERS 5.24 and 5.28 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE CONCERNING JUNK DEALERS, PAWNBROKERS, SECONDHAND DEALERS, DANCES AND DANCE HALLS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I: Chapter 5.24.010-5.24.100, Junk Dealers, Pawnbrokers and Secondhand Dealers is hereby repealed.

Section II: Chapter 5.28.010-5.28.090, Concerning Dances and Dance Halls is hereby repealed.

Section III: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, safety, and health of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
