ORDINANCE NO. 4501

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A PERMIT FOR USE OF THE SIDEWALK AS A SIDEWALK CAFE AT 225 BROADALBIN SW, PROVIDING FOR REVIEW OF THE PERMIT IN THREE MONTHS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Not withstanding the provisions of Chapter 7.68, it is hereby granted to the business known as Cheese & Crackers at 225 Broadalbin SW, Albany, Oregon, a permit for the use of a sidewalk adjoining the premises as a sidewalk cafe. This permit limits the use of the sidewalk to a distance of three feet from the face of the existing building.

Section 2: This permit shall be reviewed by the City Council three months after its effective date; and unless specifically renewed at that time, the permit herein granted shall terminate four months from its effective date.

Section 3: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the city of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
