ORDINANCE NO. 4519

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A RENEWED PERMIT FOR THE USE OF CITY SIDEWALKS FOR A MOBILE VENDING FOOD CART AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS AND PROVIDING FOR A REVIEW OF THE PERMIT IN SIX MONTHS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 7.68, it is hereby granted to Christina L. Barnes, 128 5th Avenue SE, Albany, OR 97321, a renewed permit for the use of city sidewalks to operate a mobile food vending cart. This permit limits the use of the sidewalk to a distance of three feet from the face of an existing building or street curb and is limited to the following locations:

Broadalbin and 1st Avenue Broadalbin and 2nd Avenue Broadalbin and 4th Avenue Ferry and 2nd Avenue Washington and 1st Avenue Ellsworth and 2nd Avenue

<u>Section 2</u>. This permit shall be reviewed by the City Council six months after the effective date and unless specifically renewed at that time the permit herein granted shall terminate seven months from its effective date.

Section 3: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
