

ORDINANCE NO. 4616

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 10.08.050, SEWER FUNDS.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Albany Municipal Code Section 10.08.050 is amended to read as follows:

10.08.050 Sewer funds. The "Sewer Service Fund" as established by Ordinance No. 3330 and the "Sewer Improvement Fund" as established by Ordinance No. 3486 are hereby continued.


(1) Sewer use charges. All monies received from sewer users from monthly or quarterly sewer use charges as described below shall be deposited in the Sewer Service Fund. Those funds designated by the city council to be used for sewer separation shall be transferred into the Sewer Improvement Fund. The Sewer Service Fund money shall be used for operation, maintenance, **replacement, and planning** improvements including studies or design of such improvements of the sewerage system and treatment plant, administrative costs, and other costs deemed by the city council to be necessary in the operation and maintenance of the sewerage system or treatment plant(s).

(2) Sewer connection fees. All monies received from sewer connection fees as described below shall be deposited in the Sewer Improvement Fund. Such funds shall be accounted for separately from those received from sewer use charges. Connection fee revenue shall only be used for the purpose of making major emergency repairs, extending or oversizing sewers, or constructing new additions to the treatment plant.
