ORDINANCE NO. 4620

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 1983 MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS OF THE STATE OF OREGON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: Violation of the provisions contained in Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapters 481, 482, 483, 484, 485, and 487, as now or hereinafter constituted, shall be an offense against the City of Albany and prosecution and trial thereunder shall be as provided therein.

Section 2: Albany Municipal Code Chapter 13.04.010 through 13.04.070 are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect immediately on its passage by the Council and approve by the Mayor.
