## ORDINANCE NO. 4637

AN ORDINANCE VACATING RAILROAD STREET FROM THE NORTHERN RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF FIRST AVENUE NORTH TO THE SOUTHERN RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF WATER AVENUE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany did by adoption of Resolution No. 2474, City of Albany Resolutions, at the council meeting held on the 13th day of June, 1984, set the hour of 7:15 pm o'clock on the 11th day of July, 1984, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Railroad Street from the northern right-of-way line of First Avenue north to the southern right-of-way line of Water Avenue.

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 11th day of July, 1984, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the council being fully informed.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That portion of Railroad Street from the northern right-of-way line of First Avenue north to the southern right-of-way line of Water Avenue is hereby vacated subject to the following conditions:

1. A utility easement will be reserved on the entire right-of-way.


